



**EXPRESSION OF INTEREST
FOR PROVISION OF OFFSHORE AND NEARSHORE MARITIME SURVEILLANCE
SERVICE**

Eni Rovuma Basin B.V., invites interested tenderers to submit their ***Expression of Interest for the Provision of Offshore and Nearshore Maritime Surveillance Services*** to support Company's operations at Area 4 of the Rovuma Basin, in Mozambique.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

This invitation covers for the provision of offshore and nearshore maritime surveillance services, 24h, in the Pemba bay and within the perimeters of the Area 4 of the Rovuma Basin, in compliance with the relevant legislation in force in the Republic of Mozambique and maintaining an internationally acceptable security standard for the protection of the Company and Company's assets, personnel, materials, business and information.

The maritime surveillance services shall include maritime surveillance around various companies, vessels and other assets and personnel of the various subcontractors of the Company, being that the contractor for the maritime surveillance services shall also act as a deterrent and quick response to early warning interception.

Interested tenderers must, among other requirements, be the owner or have available to provide the services, the suitable and appropriate vessels for the services which shall have all licenses and authorizations required under the Mozambican law as well as any international conventions and regulations applicable to the services.

The duration of the contract for the provision of services shall be for a firm period of two (2) years from commencement date to be indicated in the contract, with an optional one (1) year extension at Company's discretion.

DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED

The tenderers interested in this invitation may submit their *Expression of Interest* by providing the following mandatory information and documentation:

I. Technical documents:

Interested tenderers shall:

- a) Be registered in Mozambique, and submit all necessary licenses and authorizations for the services as required under the Mozambican law;
- b) Submit the copies of the necessary insurances covering the services, personnel, vessels and any other equipment to be used during the provision of services;
- c) Provide any relevant references for previously executed projects of similar technical characteristics and magnitude;
- d) CONTRACTOR shall provide a HSE Management System Manual evidencing alignment with international standards on HSE (e.g. ISO 14001, OHSAS 18001/ISO 45001) and/or a list of HSE documentation (e.g. procedures) related to the Scope of Works activities.

II. Administrative documents:

Without prejudice to the above, Tenderers must submit, among others:

- a) Scanned certified copy of (i) License to exercise commercial activities ("*Alvará Comercial*"); (ii) Certificate of registration of legal entities; (iii) name and contact person for receiving qualification package and other relevant information from the Company;
- b) Last three years' financial statements and annual report including balance sheet, profit and loss and cash flow statement. These documents must be provided for the tenderer's group of companies (if applicable), and also for the tenderer's Mozambican registered entity that will enter into the subject contract;
- c) Certificate of registration in Mozambique. In case tenderer is not already registered in Mozambique, please specify if it would be willing to promptly register in Mozambique;
- d) Tenderer and tenderer's group structure with the list of major shareholders and ultimate beneficiaries (if not listed in the stock exchange).
- e) In case tenderer wish to participate in the Expression of Interest as a consortium, information about each member of the consortium and role of each participant in the consortium. Such intention to form a consortium, must be supported by an agreement or "Memorandum of Understanding" duly signed by each entity member of the proposed consortium.
